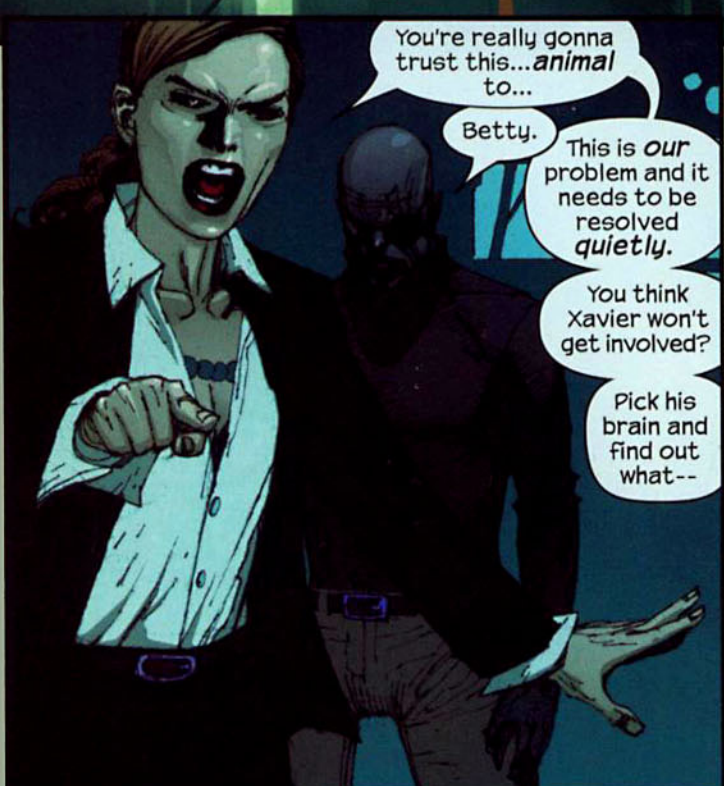

For sure? Not very.

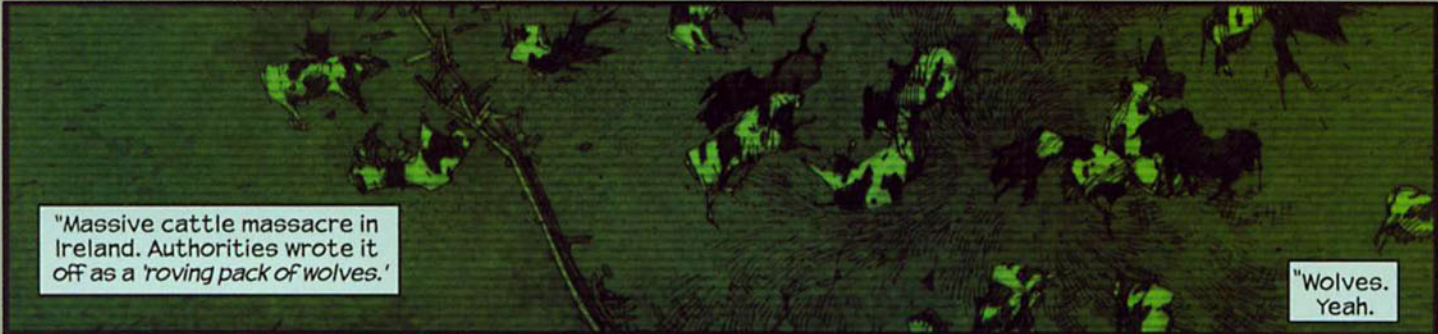
But...

...*incidents* that got our radar up.

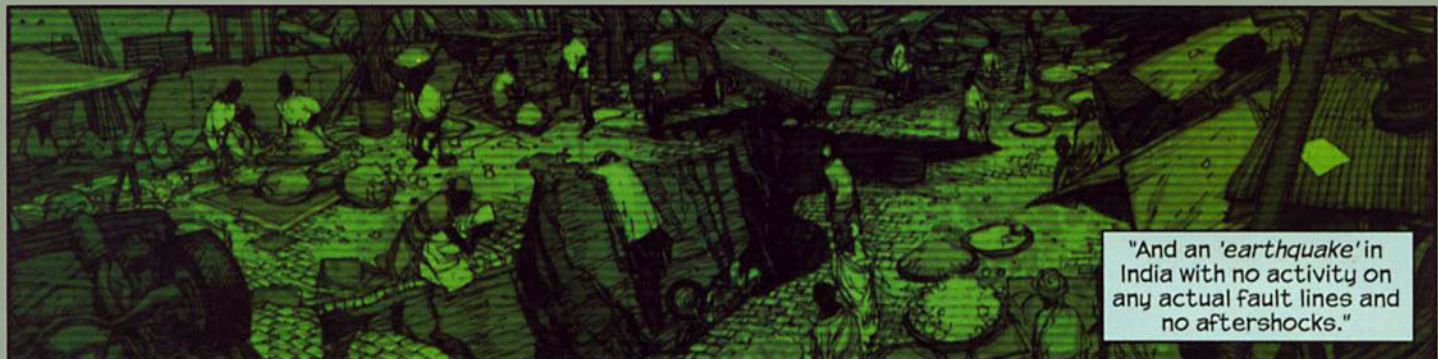


"Bombing in Paris leveled an entire building. But no bomb materials turned up. No fire. No group taking responsibility."

...inevitability to finding out what's causing them.

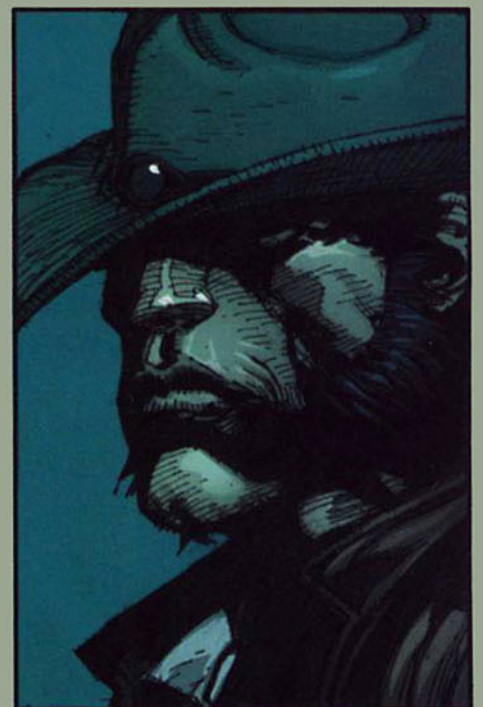
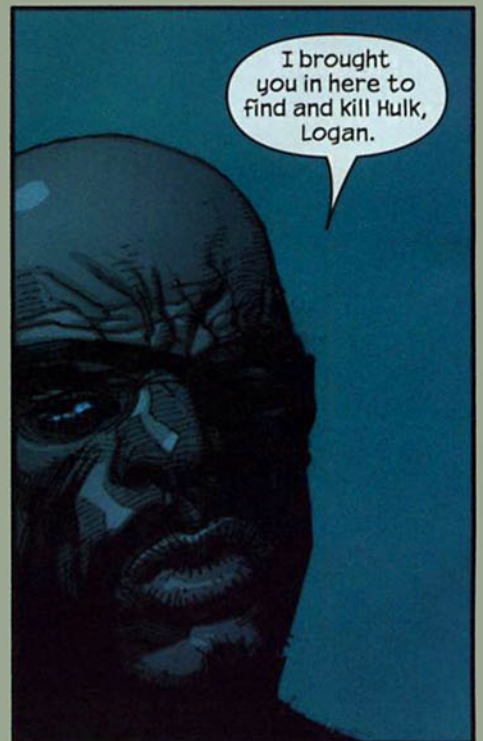
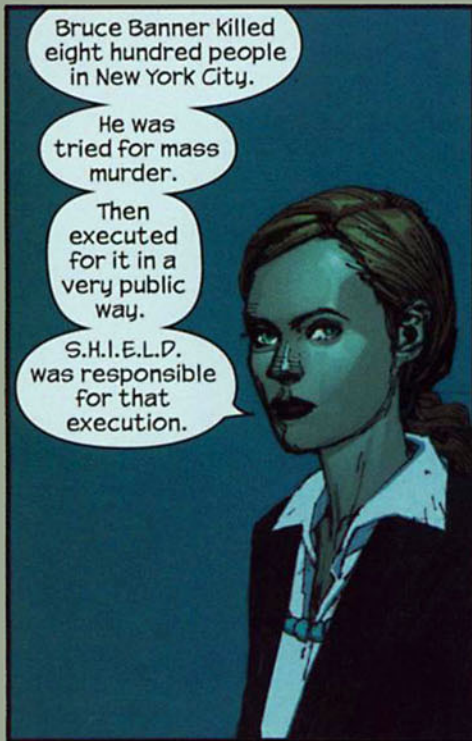
And what's causing them, Nick?

I guess it's all relative, huh?



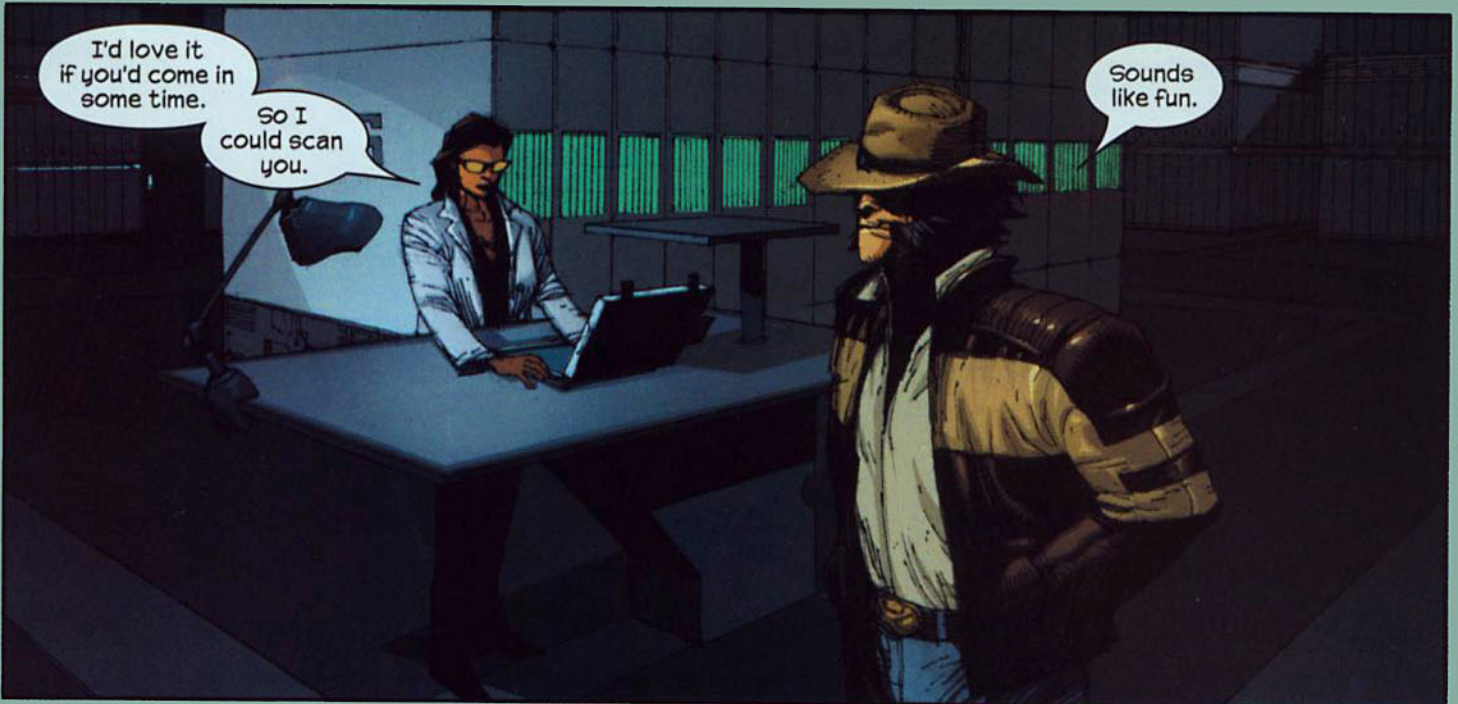


I hear your bones are laced with Adamantium.

I'm curious about your joints.



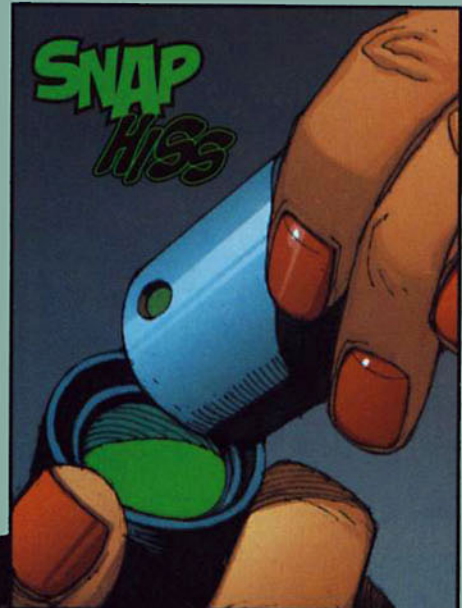

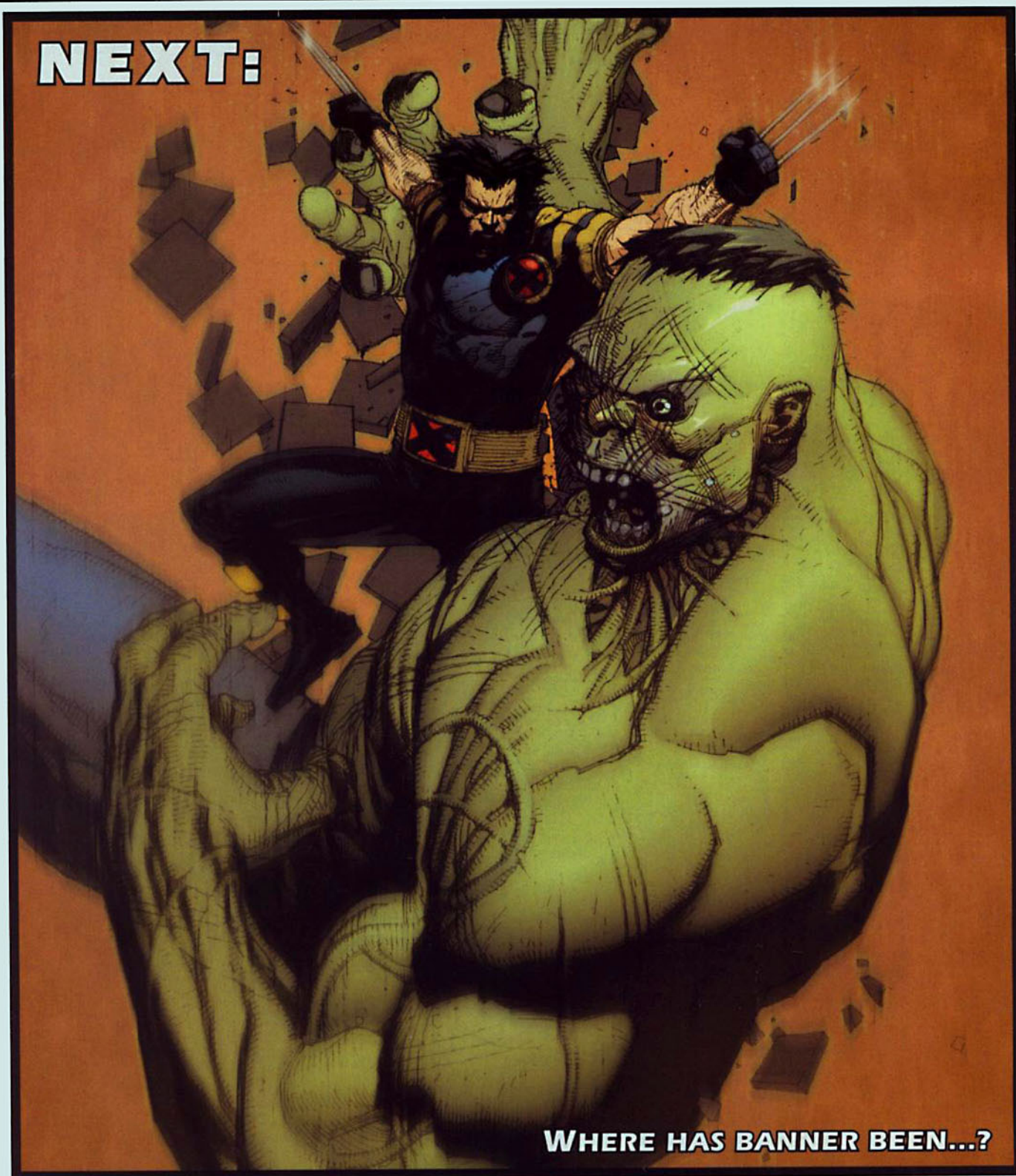
